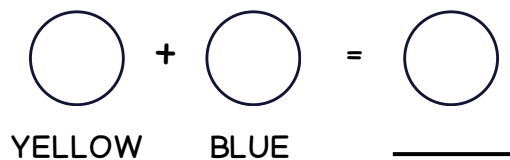
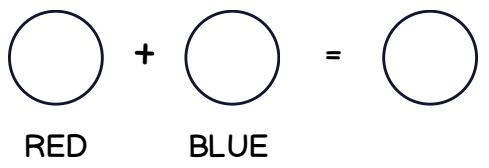
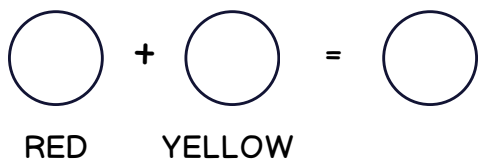
Read, color

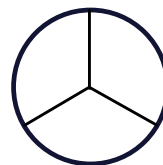

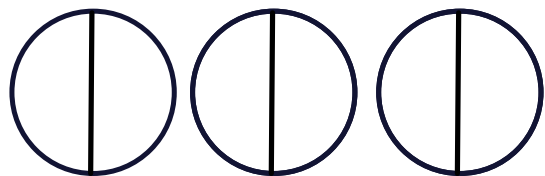

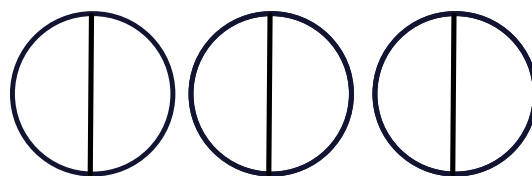

ANALOGOUS COLORS

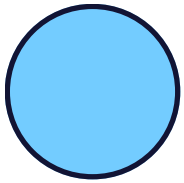


They are close neighbors on the color wheel

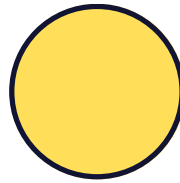

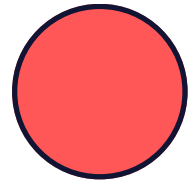

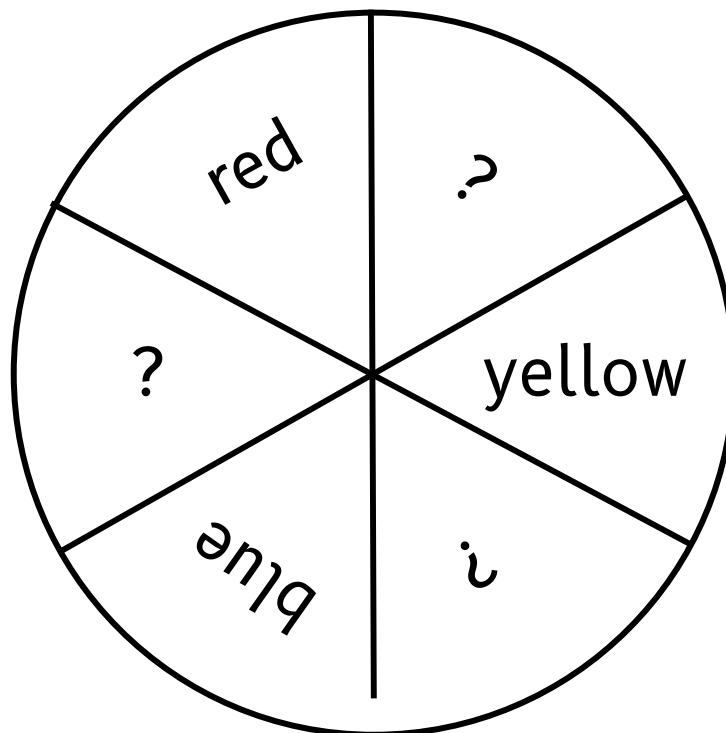

EZ-Tip: Experimenting with colors can help you understand how they should mix. A lot of color combinations end up making brown, and adding black or white can make it darker or lighter.

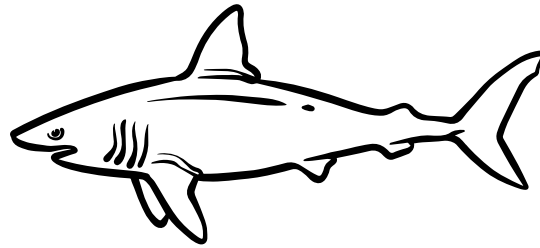
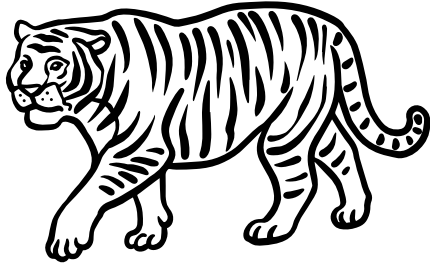
